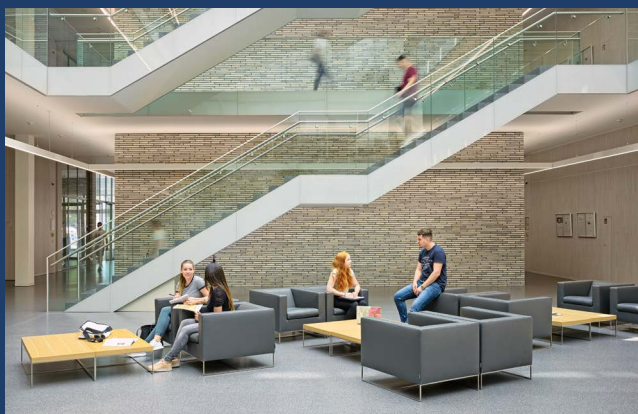

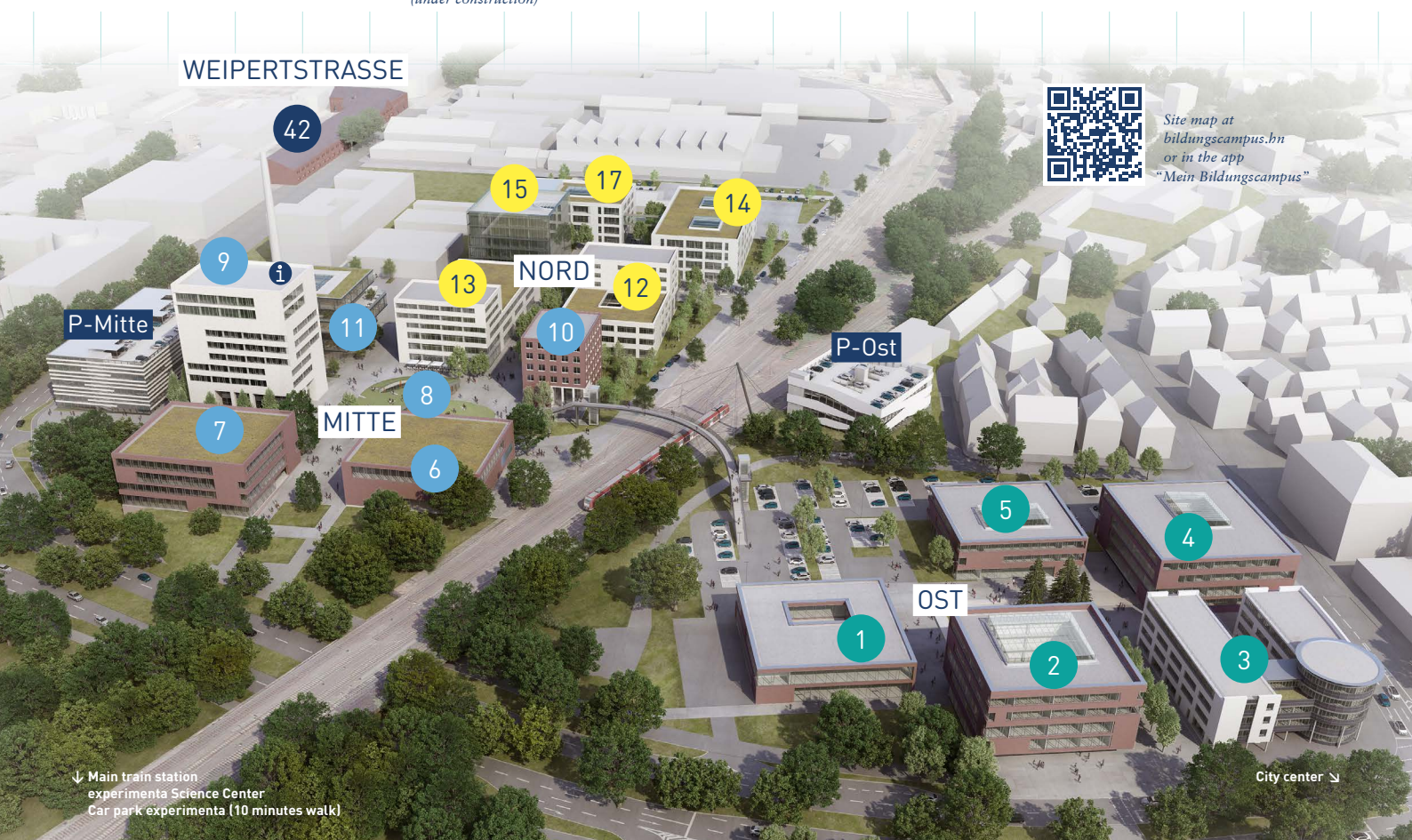

Students with a graduation from Middle School must attend the vocational college (1BKSP) for a year before proceeding to the PiA Education.
